History of false teachings

- Possibly Gnosticism
- Self-reliance
- Hypocrisy
- Do we have false teaching today?

- Order; the way God designed it to work, His design for Christian living

- Center of God's will

- \_\_\_\_\_ of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen (Hebrews 11:1)
- Our Christian life has to be one of faith

- Charity, agape love = expects \_\_\_\_\_ in return
- Fulfills the law (Romans 13:10, Matthew 22:37)
- We must live this love outwardly around us

- Clean, clear
- Thoughts or feelings (\_\_\_\_\_)
- Pure, holy, undefiled

Good \_\_\_\_\_...(opposite = one laden with guilt)

- Moral conscience - become aware; awaken; co-perception (God \_\_\_\_\_)
- Can't become seared (1 Timothy 4:2) – no longer does \_\_\_\_\_ seem \_\_\_\_\_
- When conviction comes, \_\_\_\_\_?
- Exercise it daily – Acts 24:6 (reflection, listening, acting)

- This is the action part – false Christianity is just saying it and not living it
